




Figure 3-1 – Influence of the time since geocache placement on the number of (a) quests and (b) favourites.





Figure 3-2 - Descriptive analysis of geocache distance from (a) residential areas, (b) road network, (c) public transport and (d) the coast.





Figure 4-1 - Distribution of geocache hunter questionnaire respondents according to the (a) age and (b) educational attainment.
